Notice of Public Listening Sessions on the Issue of Interoperability

The Wisconsin State Interoperability Executive Council (SIEC), created by Governor Jim Doyle's Executive Order 87 in February 2005, is charged with improving and developing interoperable public safety communication systems in Wisconsin. To fulfill this mission, it will take more than the work of the SIEC alone. A comprehensive statewide effort must be undertaken to ensure that this issue, the importance of which was immediately shown following the tragic events of September 11th, is given the attention it deserves.

To achieve this mission, the SIEC will be holding regional listening sessions throughout the State of Wisconsin to hear from first responders, local, tribal and state officials, as well as any other interested parties to hear their perspective **on the proposed Technical Interoperability Plan** for the State of Wisconsin. The technical plan represents a considerable step towards achieving full interoperability in the state of Wisconsin. The plan is the combination of the expertise of the technical subcommittee and the feedback received at numerous listening sessions conducted throughout the state early last year.
