**ROLL CALL AND INTRODUCTION OF MEMBERS**

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE ELIGIBILITY AND INVITATION OF ENTITIES FOR WISCOM FEE-BASED DAILY USE**

Rich McVicar gave an overview of the user fee category model and requested feedback for revisions. Discussion ensued to define local and wide area use of WISCOM in relationship to structuring a fee scale. Different categories of use were also defined to determine how federal, municipal, and private agencies might utilize WISCOM for private or public use versus for profit or non-profit activities and events. Specific questions would be asked of agencies that would determine their fee requirements.

The Sustainability Workgroup decided that more work is required to clearly define user fees and that a report of progress on this will be brought to the SSMG at the December 22<sup>nd</sup>.
